

Integer Subtraction Problems

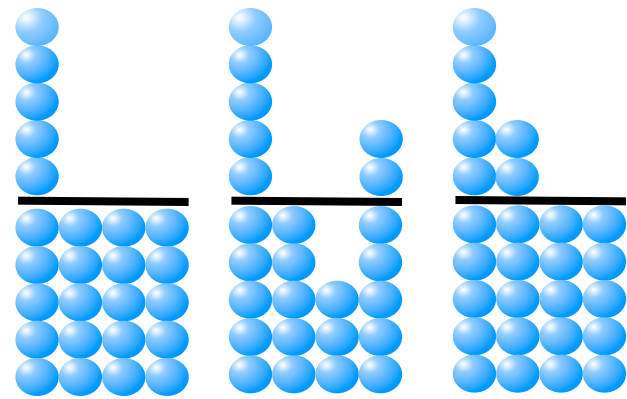
Subtraction: Positive + Negative

When you have finished working all of the problems,
your teacher will show you the correct answers.

1.)	When John woke up the temperature outside was 5 degrees above zero. When he left for school the temperature was two degrees below zero. How much had the temperature changed?
2.)	Tasha lost two points for problems she had worked wrong. The teacher noticed the answer key was incorrect and gave her the points back. . If Tasha's score was four before the correction, what was it afterward?
3.)	Karla had three pet rabbits. If she gave her brother one of the rabbits, how many rabbits did she have left?
4.)	Juan paid three dollars to rent a movie. When he took the movie back the store owner said he was going to take one dollar off of his bill since he was such a good customer. How much did Juan end up paying?
5.)	After a two dollar discount Jack paid three dollars for a new game. When the store owner realized the sale was over he took back the two dollar discount. How much did Jack pay for the game?

1.)

When John woke up the temperature outside was 5 degrees above zero. When he left for school the temperature was two degrees below zero. How much had the temperature changed?

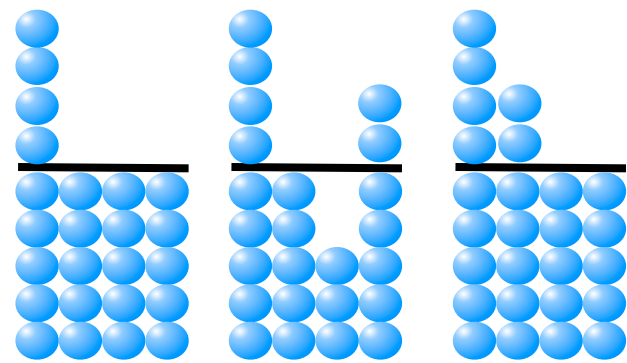


$$+5 -^{-} 2 = + 7$$

The temperature went up three degrees.

2.)

Tasha lost two points for problems she had worked wrong. The teacher noticed the answer key was incorrect and gave her the points back. . If Tasha's score was four before the correction, what was it afterward?

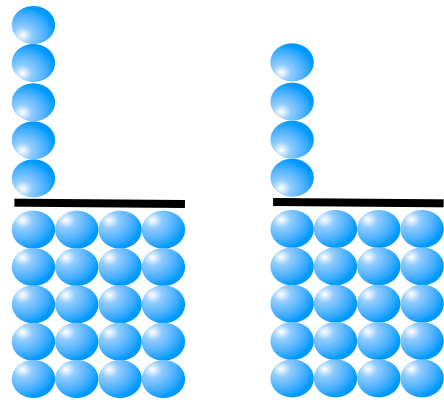


$$4 -^{-} 2 = 6$$

Tasha's score was 6 points after the correction.

3.)

Karla had five pet rabbits. If she gave her brother one of the rabbits, how many rabbits did she have left?

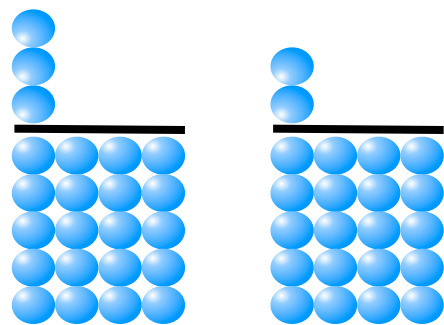


$$+5 - +1 = +4$$

Karla had four rabbits left.

4.)

Juan paid three dollars to rent a movie. When he took the movie back the store owner said he was going to take one dollar off of his bill since he was such a good customer. How much did Juan end up paying?

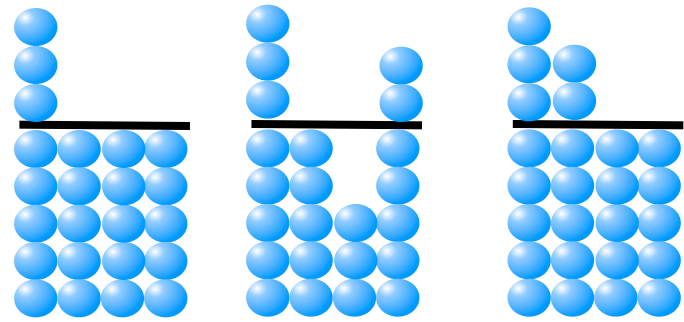


$$+3 - +1 = +2$$

Juan paid two dollars to rent the movie.

5.)

After a two dollar discount Jack paid three dollars for a new game. When the store owner realized the sale was over he took back the two dollar discount. How much did Jack pay for the game?



$$+3 - 2 = +5$$

The submarine was one foot lower than where it started.
