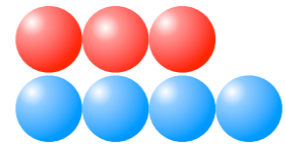
# Additional Problems

## **Combining Sets**

1.)	Jack has 3 dogs and Marty has 4 cats. How many animals do they have all together?
2.)	Tasha ate five pieces of pizza and Karen ate four pieces of pizza. How many pieces of pizza did they eat all together?
3.)	Larry had 8 pencils and his brother gave him 6 more pencils. How many pencils does Larry have all together?
4.)	Latoya's mother gave her five dollars for her birthday and her grandmother gave her seven dollars for her birthday. How much money did Latoya get for her birthday?
5.)	Maria has nine sea shells. Maria's brother went on a trip and brought her back four more sea shells. How many sea shells does Maria now have?

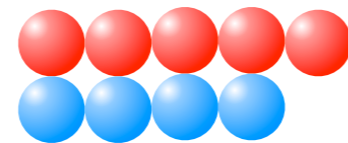
1.) Jack has 3 dogs and Marty has 4 cats. How many animals do they have all together?



$$3 + 4 = 7$$

Jack and Marty have seven animals all together.

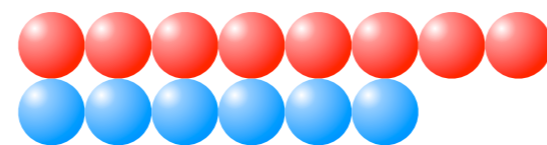
2.) Tasha ate five pieces of pizza and Karen ate four pieces of pizza. How many pieces of pizza did they eat all together?



$$5 + 4 = 9$$

Together, Tasha and Karen ate nine pieces of pizza.

3.) Larry had 8 pencils and his brother gave him 6 more pencils. How many pencils does Larry have all together?

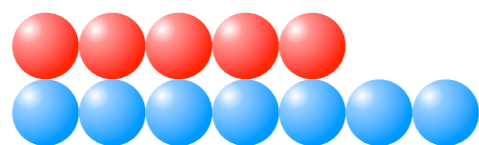


$$8 + 6 = 14$$

Larry would have a total of fourteen pencils.

4.)

Latoya's mother gave her five dollars for her birthday and her grandmother gave her seven dollars for her birthday. How much money did Latoya get for her birthday?

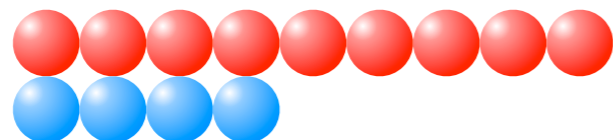


$$5 + 7 = 12$$

Latoya got twelve dollars for her birthday.

5.)

Maria has nine sea shells. Maria's brother went on a trip and brought her back four more sea shells. How many sea shells does Maria now have?



$$9 + 4 = 13$$

Maria has thirteen sea shells all together.
